

MBSANZ 2018 invites you to submit abstracts on a broad spectrum of topics related to matrix biology.

Programme themes include, but are not limited to:

- Neuroscience
- Imaging
- Biomaterials
- Matrix in Disease
- Therapeutics
- Techniques in Matrix Biology

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated on the basis of the relevance to matrix biology, scientific, technological, and clinical impact.

Abstracts are submitted with the understanding that, if accepted, the presenting author will register and attend the meeting.

Notification of acceptance or rejection will be communicated to the authors in October 2018.

Abstract structure

- The title of the abstract should be centred and in bold letters.
- The authors' names should start with their initials, followed by surname.
- The affiliations of all authors should be provided, including Institute, City and Country.
- The abstract should be broken down into Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion/Conclusion, and not exceed 250 words.
- No figures, photos or graphs are allowed.
- MBSANZ assumes that all authors have approved the submitted abstract.
- All abstracts must be written in English.
